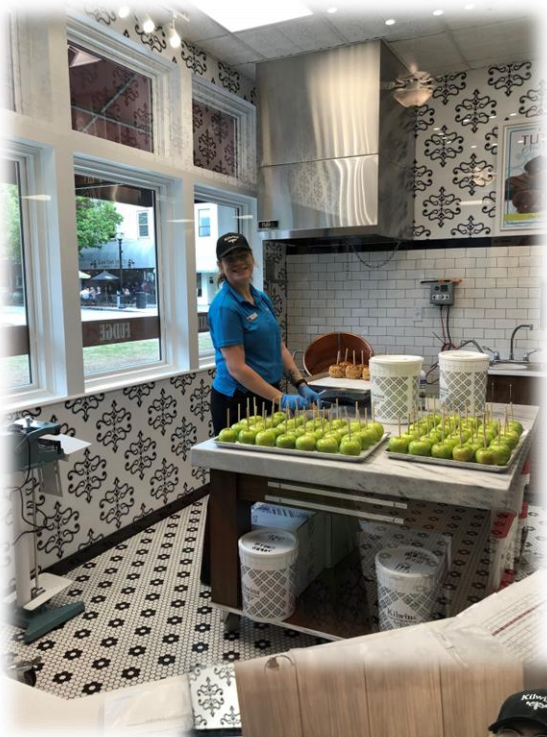

Georgia Department of Education 2023 Priorities

[\(downloadable/print version\)](#)

- **Strengthening Opportunities for Students**
- **PRIORITY:** Expand access to educational opportunities that prepare students for life by establishing elementary-level Career, Technical, and Agricultural Education courses.
- **PRIORITY:** Increase opportunities for high-school students to gain valuable workplace experience by providing state funding to extend Work-Based Learning programs into the summer months.
- **Strengthening the Teaching Profession and Educator Pipeline**
- **PRIORITY:** Support the Governor's legislative initiative to increase the paraprofessional-to-teacher pipeline by providing state funds to offset the certification costs of becoming a teacher.

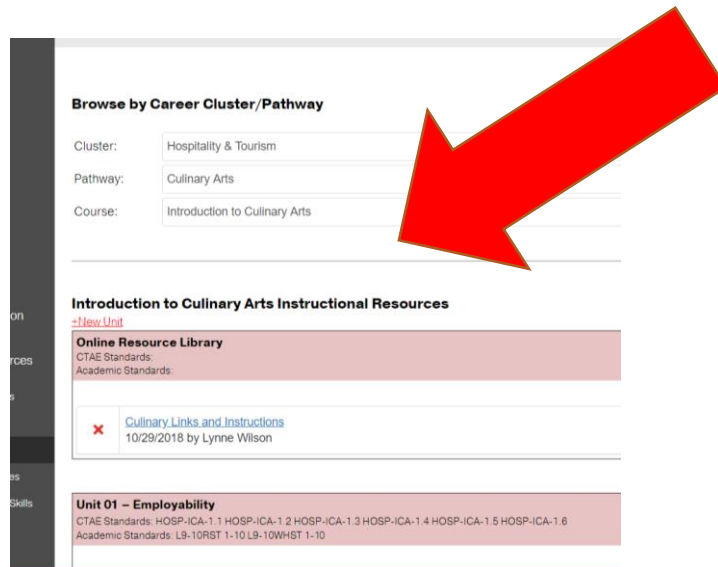

Questions about Extended Day

Why can't I do Prostart, Future Georgia Educators, EdRising, SkillsUSA or any other student organization?

Simple Answer is **YES** you can do any of these.

However, our State Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) is **FCCLA**. To receive your Extended Day Grant, you must complete your Program of Work in FCCLA first.

Any other opportunities you are giving your students is WONDERFUL. But remember these do not count on your Extended Day Program of Work.

What is a CRE Grant?

Construction Related Equipment

These are grants for **new** buildings, **additional** buildings or **renovated** classrooms.

If your CTAE Director asks you for an **EQUIPMENT LIST** for Construction Related Equipment Grant (CRE), they must request a list from me first. Then when you are compiling your list...

Ask yourself these questions:

1. Is it over \$100?
2. Is it “true” equipment and not supplies?
3. Is it a single item and not a “package deal or kit”?
4. Does it have a lifespan of over 5 years?
5. Can it be repaired?
6. Is it related directly to your curriculum?

If YES, then it can be bought with CRE grant funds.

CRE Equipment Grant is ONLY for a -

*New build or addition or modifying classroom

*A total of 18 months process

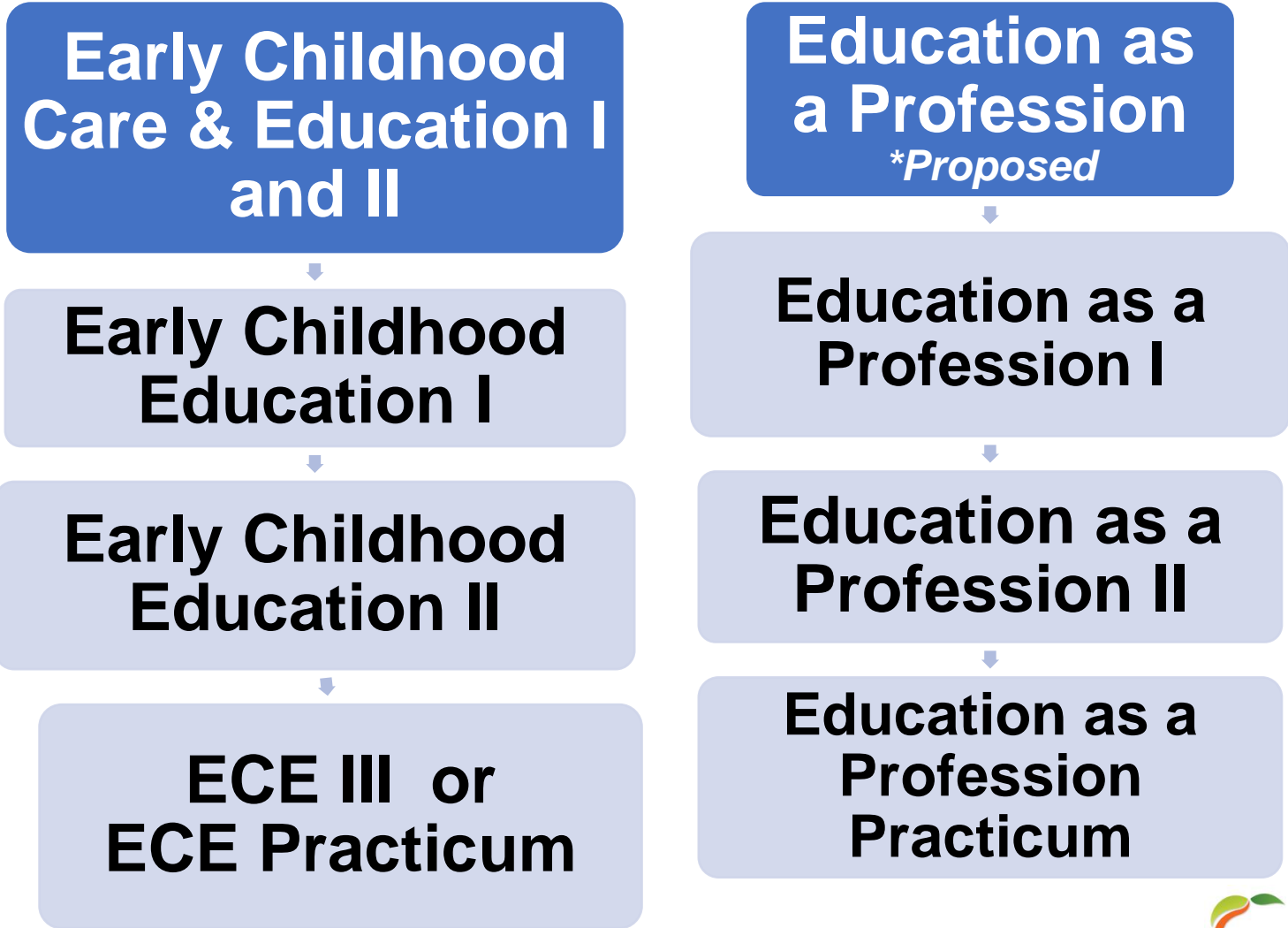

Here is a quick look at the ways to receive transfer credit to the University System of Georgia (USG) or the Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) for completing the Education Pathway.

Important!

- *Gather all vital documents before your graduation date.
- *Have an official transcript.
- *Some colleges will ask for a digital version of your portfolio and others will ask for a hard-copy.
- *Have Registrar's Letter with school administration signature.

1. Pass Education as a Profession pathway courses with a C or better
2. Complete Portfolio
3. Pass State Approved Assessment

Requirements for EDUC 2110:

1. Pass Early Childhood Education pathway courses with a C or better
2. Complete Portfolio
3. Pass State Approved Assessment

Requirements for ECCE 1101 and ECCE 1103:

1. Pass ECE I, ECE II, and ECE III with a "B" or better*
 2. Pass NOCTI with a 70% or better
 3. No Portfolio required
- *May ask technical college if will accept ECE Practicum.*
