

# GATFACS Winter Conference - Winter Business Meeting Great Wolf, LaGrange, GA January 26, 2024

Kristen Rogers GACTFACS, President welcomed and called the meeting to order at 10:28 am.

**Secretary Report,** Sheryl Parks. The minutes from the June 14, 2023 meeting were presented for approval by the members. The minutes are housed in the GATFACS Google Drive. Minutes were submitted for posting on the GATFACS website. Amanda Foley motioned to approve the minutes. The motion was second. Minutes were approved as distributed.

**Financial Report:** Megan Ford Scott presented the financial reports. Balance as of July 1, 2023 was \$139,139. Income of \$88,334 from membership and Winter Conference registration fees. Disbursements for the year total \$15, 566, Balance of accounts as of January 26, 2024 was \$211,907. A copy will be filed with the secretary.
